### **Preface**

Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth.

Worship the LORD with gladness;
come before him with joyful songs.

Know that the LORD is God.

It is he who made us, and we are his;
we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.

Enter his gates with thanksgiving

give thanks to him and praise his name.

Sing With Me is an invitation to sing with children not because you need to fill time or prepare for a program or even because you've always done so—but because God has invited us to sing. God commands us to sing. The Psalms are filled with invitations to sing and worship (Ps. 95, 96, and 98 come readily to mind). And what greater reason to sing than that "the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations" (Ps. 100:5).

In the Psalms singing is most often associated with praise, but the psalmists also utter prayers and laments. Similarly, within this collection you will find songs of praise, songs to sing just for the joy of singing and moving, songs that are prayers, and songs that address the hurts that even children experience.

In the Psalms singing is intertwined with testimonies to God's greatness and faithfulness, recitations of the things God has done throughout history. In the notes to these songs you will often find suggestions for discussing the song lyrics and connecting them with our daily living. As a song leader or teacher, make use of opportunities whenever possible to share your own faith story.

When you read psalms of praise, you sometimes sense praise and exuberance gushing forth from the psalmist, and you can imagine that energy being fueled creatively through instruments and dance. You will find plenty of suggestions for doing just that in the song notes in this . In most cases the instrumental parts are meant to be playable by children themselves and are therefore very simple.

May God bless you as you extend the invitation to Sing With Me.

#### More About Sing With Me

Sing With Me is connected to a curriculum for children that follows a long line of church school curricula incorporating music to help children learn. Walk With Me, a Sunday school curriculum launched in 2004 by Faith Alive Christian Resources, uses hundreds of songs throughout its materials for children in preschool through grade 8, and Sing With Me follows up by compiling many of those songs—and more—into a single song. This leader's edition includes full accompaniments, information on the songs, ideas for their use, signing, motions, and instrumental parts. A children's edition published in 2006 includes simplified arrangements of these songs. Sing With Me is therefore a great resource not only for Sunday school but also for congregational worship, Christian day schools, home schools, families, and even young piano students.

Approximately half of the song is made up of a wide range of songs from the various age levels of the *Walk With Me* curriculum, including "God's Not Dead," "Joshua Fought the Battle of Jericho," "Praise to the Infant King," "Amigos de Cristo," "Every Move I Make," "Angels We Have Heard on High," "One, Two, Three, Jesus Loves Me," and many others. To help connect this song to *Walk With Me*, we have chosen to use the categories used in the curriculum: *Hello, Know, Grow,* and *Show. Hello* is the opening or gathering time, *Know* focuses on teaching God's story from creation to re-creation, *Grow* is about our growing relationship to God, and *Show* is about taking the gospel message out into the world. You will also find subsections that correlate with the elements of a worship service. (For more information on *Walk With Me*, call 1-800-333-8300 or visit www.FaithAliveResources.org.)

Though this leader's edition is filled with useful ideas, be sure to make your own efforts to be creative. Play around with different percussive sounds and rhythms till you find a sound you like. Work with children in finding ways to express the lyrics and mood of songs through art or movement. There is no right or wrong expression if it is authentic and honoring to God.

### **Preface**

How many specific lessons do you remember from Sunday school? Probably not very many. But how about the songs you sang in Sunday school? Do you remember the words to "If You're Happy and You Know It," "Away in a Manger," or "Oh, Be Careful, Little Eyes"?

Choosing songs for children to sing is a priestly task. It is priestly because the chooser of the song puts words into the mouths of children—words that are used in speaking to or of God. These sung words become the foundational expressions of children's faith. The pairing of text and music is powerful—so powerful that St. Augustine wavered between encouraging singing and wanting to stop the practice altogether. But singing has been an important way to praise God since the dawn of time (Job 38:7), and because it's a good learning tool and an enjoyable activity, we use it for the glory of God.
